The Washington Old Time Fiddlers Association is a non-profit organization formed in 1965 to preserve and promote old time fiddle music and related traditional arts. Statewide, we have about 1,000 members, arranged geographically into districts. New members of all ages are welcome (you do not have to be a musician to join). Membership benefits include the opportunity to attend the annual summer music workshop described below, plus monthly newsletters which publicize statewide activities and sheet music for a selected song each month.

We are a very active organization statewide and perform at a variety of venues including nursing and retirement homes, senior centers, clubs, service groups, state fairs, and WOTFA sponsored shows. Donations and ticket sales from these functions are used to cover our operating expenses.

In July, we host a week long fiddle, guitar, mandolin and bass workshop in Moses Lake, taught by nationally recognized artists. Many districts sponsor campouts throughout Washington state that are great opportunities to jam, socialize and learn new tunes.

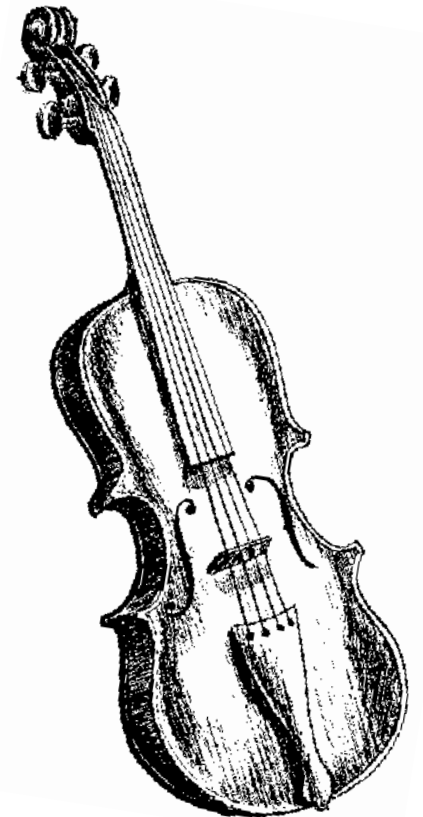
